This matter is before the court on the *Petition for Rehearing or Rehearing En* Banc of Intervenors HollyFrontier Cheyenne Refining, LLC, HollyFrontier Refining & Marketing, LLC, and HollyFrontier Woods Cross Refining ("Holly Frontier Petition") and Intervenor-Respondent Wynnewood Refining Company, LLC's Petition for Rehearing En Banc ("Wynnewood Petition").
