FEDERAL DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO CONTINUE STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

The United States Environmental Protection Agency and the United States Army (collectively, "Federal Defendants") hereby move for a stay of all proceedings in this case pending a decision from the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit on the question of its jurisdiction under 33 U.S.C. § 1369(b)(1) to review challenges to the Clean Water Rule, 80 Fed. Reg. 37,054 (June 29, 2015). For the reasons stated in the attached memorandum of law, Federal Defendants request that the Court grant the motion.

¹ This case was initially stayed pending a decision from the United States Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation, and the Panel has now ruled.

Counsel for Defendants conferred with counsel for Plaintiffs regarding this motion. Counsel for Plaintiffs indicated that Plaintiffs consent to a stay of proceedings in this Court until the Sixth Circuit issues a decision on jurisdiction, or until the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals issues a decision on the same jurisdictional issue in *Georgia v. McCarthy*, No. 15-14035 (11th Cir.), whichever comes sooner.²
