<p>The role of the Mediator/ Conflict Resolvers intervenes when there is conflict.</p>

<p>When the presenter/ facilitator is ready for questions, the stacker will call out the folks in the order in which they were raised. When time is limited and we can only entertain a few questions, the presenter may state the number of questions they can take, and after that last spot is claimed, the stacker writes in the comments END STACK. The Timekeeper can also write down END STACK if the conversation needs to come to an end. The stacker supports the Facilitators and the meeting by keeping track of the questions/ comments.</p>
