JOINT STATUS REPORT

The Parties jointly submit this Status Report pursuant to this Court’s Order entered February 3, 2023 [ECF 640] to advise the Court as to the status of the MDL.

Active Cases in the MDL

In the Coy's Honey Farm Inc. case (1:21-cv-00089), the parties are presently engaged in expert discovery.

There have been settlement discussions in the Flamm Orchard case (4:18-cv-01849) but no resolution. A Case Management Order was entered on November 28, 2023.

The Parties are not aware of any other cases in the MDL that are not otherwise addressed or covered by the Soybean Growers Settlement (discussed below).

Soybean Growers Settlement

There have been 450 soybean settlement claims approved, and there are currently 72 claims on appeal to the Appeals Master. The parties have been streamlining the work of the auditor to expedite finalization of the settlement. Settlement payments to claimants have begun.
