Federal Case

• <u>Lynnville Transport, Inc. v. Chao</u>, 316 F.Supp. 2d 790 (S.D. Iowa 2004) (affirming DOL penalties for minors' use of skid loader to move manure when shovel not raised from lowest level, stating, "The law applies equally to the employer who acts with the best of intentions as it does to the employer who would subject minor laborers to dangerous and abusive conditions.")
