ORDER

This matter is before the Court on Defendants' Renewed Motion to Stay Proceedings for 90 Days (Doc. 107), which Plaintiffs oppose in part (Doc. 108).

On February 21, 2025, the Court stayed this Administrative Procedures Act action for 60 days on Defendants' request, due to the change in presidential administrations. Doc. 105. Defendants had sought a stay of 90 days, while Plaintiffs opposed a stay longer than 30 days. Docs. 102, 104. The Court had previously granted Defendants' request for a 30-day continuance of the hearing on the parties' crossmotions for summary judgment, which was originally scheduled for January 24, 2025. *See* Docs. 98, 99, 100.

Defendants now seek an additional 90-day stay. Doc. 107. They explain that "the new administration requires further time to review the litigation and the challenged rulemaking," and note that "multiple appointed positions at [the Department of Labor] have yet to be confirmed[.]" *Id.* at 2. Plaintiffs again oppose a

stay longer than 30 days, asserting that they are suffering ongoing harm from the rule

that they are challenging in this action. Doc. 108.

These proceedings have now been continued or stayed for more than four

months. Defendants' latest motion fails to demonstrate that an additional stay is

appropriate at this time, particularly in light of Plaintiffs' allegations of ongoing harm.

Accordingly, Defendants' renewed motion to stay is due to be denied. The hearing on

the cross-motions for summary judgment will be rescheduled by separate order.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED**:

1. Defendants' Motion to Stay Proceedings for 90 Days (Doc. 107) is

DENIED.

2. The Clerk is directed to lift the stay of this action and reopen this case.
