REPORT TO COMMISSION OFFICER. 20 ANY PERSON WHO KILLS ANY GAME OR WILDLIFE, OTHER THAN RACCOONS, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBCHAPTER SHALL, WITHIN 21 22 24 HOURS, REPORT, ORALLY OR IN WRITING, THE KILLING TO AN 23 OFFICER OF THE COMMISSION. THE REPORT SHALL SET FORTH THE DATE, 24 TIME AND PLACE OF THE KILLING, THE NUMBER OF SPECIES KILLED [AND THE SEX OF THE SPECIES.], THE SEX OF THE SPECIES AND THE 25 LOCATION OF EACH CARCASS. 1 § 2125. SURRENDER OF CARCASS [TO COMMISSION OFFICER].

2 EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBCHAPTER, THE ENTIRE 3 CARCASS, INCLUDING THE HEAD AND HIDE, OF ALL BIG GAME ANIMALS AND THE ENTIRE CARCASS OF ANY OTHER GAME OR WILDLIFE, OTHER THAN 4 RACCOONS, LESS ENTRAILS, SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE, UNLESS 5 OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY AN OFFICER OF THE COMMISSION, INTACT, 6 7 [LESS ENTRAILS,] TO ANY COMMISSION OFFICER CALLING FOR THEM[.] 8 OR DELIVERED TO A PROCESSOR FOR FINAL DISPOSITION. Killing game or wildlife to protect person. * * * 23 24 (b) Report, safekeeping and investigation. -- A person killing 25 any game or wildlife under this subchapter shall report the 26 event to an officer as soon as possible following the incident 27 but in no case later than 24 hours, provide for safekeeping of 28 the game or wildlife intact at the place where it was killed and

29 be available for interview by the officer. [The person killing

30 the game or wildlife shall answer, without evasion, any
